

Hello guten tag (GOO-ten-tahk) Goodbye auf wiedersehen (owf VEE-dur-zan) Please bitte (BIHT-tuh) Thank You danke schön (DAN-kuh shurn) You're Welcome bitte schön (BIHT-tuh shurn Pardon Me entschuldigen sie (ent-SHOOL-dee-gun zee) English? Englisch? (ENG-leesh) Yes a (yah) Nonein (sounds like "nine")



There is a German holiday known as Fasching or Fastnacht (Shrovetide). It lasts several days in February and March
