- Open to all students, regardless of any previous experience
- Unpaid, but for-credit
- No previous internship experience needed
- As much a cultural experience as the tasks or projects you're assigned







- Students selecting Education, Psychology, Not-for-profits and the Legal and Justice areas must bring a valid <u>Police</u> <u>Check</u> from the U.S. with them to London
- Students selecting Politics must submit a political paragraph
- Students selecting Journalism must submit writing samples
- Students selecting Fashion Design, Graphic Design or Creative Arts must submit a portfolio

- Internship Interviews & Prep
- Get Settled and Get to Know Your City

#### **Mid-Term Break**

One Full Week

#### Last 7 Weeks

- Internship Placement and Seminars (Approx. 160 hrs)
- Some Courses Continue

#### **Summer: London**

- Internship 2.5 Days/Week
  - Approx. 160 hours
- Courses 2.5 Days/Week
  - International Internship Course
  - British Life & Cultures

#### **Summer: Dublin**

- Internship 4 Days/Week
  - Approx. 256 hours
- Course 1x/Week
  - International Internship Course




### How to Intern with FIE

- Select Your Preferred Program
  - London Fall or Spring Semester
  - London Summer Quarter
  - Dublin Semester or Summer Quarter
- Meet with Cal Poly Intl Center Advisor
- Submit Cal Poly Study Abroad Application
- Once approved by Cal Poly:
  - Submit FIE General Application and then FIE's Internship-Specific Application
  - Pick Your 3 Internship Industry Areas
  - Submit Resume & Cover Letter
  - Answer Internship-Specific App. Questions
- Once Accepted by FIE into the Program:
  - You'll be assigned an FIE Internship Mentor
  - Refine Materials
  - Arrive Overseas, Learn Placement, Interview

### Logistical Matters

- Requirements:
  - GPA Min: 2.75
  - At least 1 year of college completed before you go abroad
- How competitive?
  - We can accept as many students as want to apply
  - Some specific internship industry areas are competitive, so flexibility is key in your choices
- Applications accepted on rolling basis with deadlines (but can be flexible)
- Fall Apr 15; Spring Oct 15; Summer March 15
  - Be aware of any Cal Poly-specific deadlines
- You'll receive an official transcript from Drexel University in Pennsylvania

- Deadline 1 month before program app deadline


