

- We offer internships, service/volunteer opportunities and intercultural learning on all our programs.



Types of Internships

✓ SUMMER GLOBAL INTERNSHIPS

✓ 8 weeks, 6 credits – full-time internship and seminar

✓ SEMESTER GLOBAL INTERNSHIPS

 Full semester – 6 weeks of coursework with a full-time 12-week, part-time internship and seminar – up to 15 credits

✓ PART-TIME INTERNSHIPS

 Elective, part-time internships as part of a study abroad semester

✓ VIRTUAL GLOBAL INTERNSHIPS

- 8 & 12-week for credit and non-credit project-based online internships
 - some institutions do not allow this option
