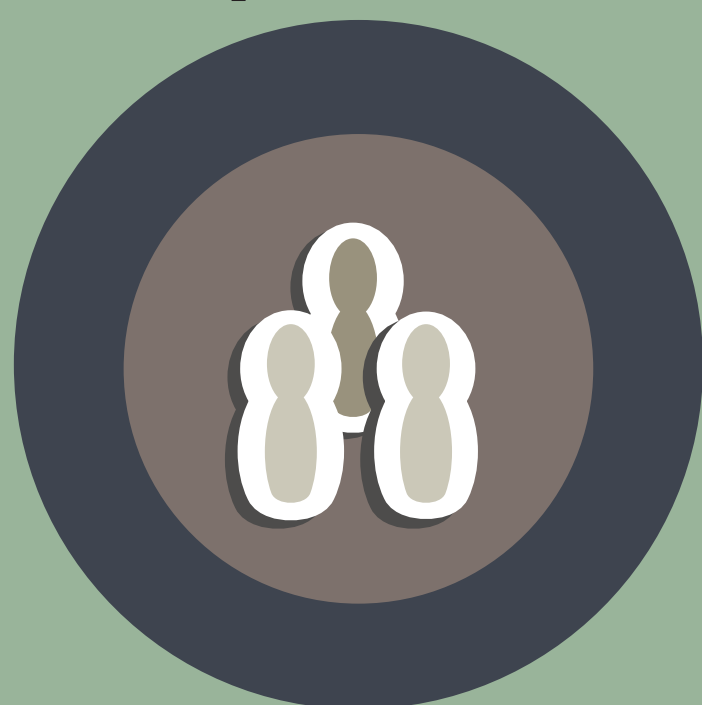

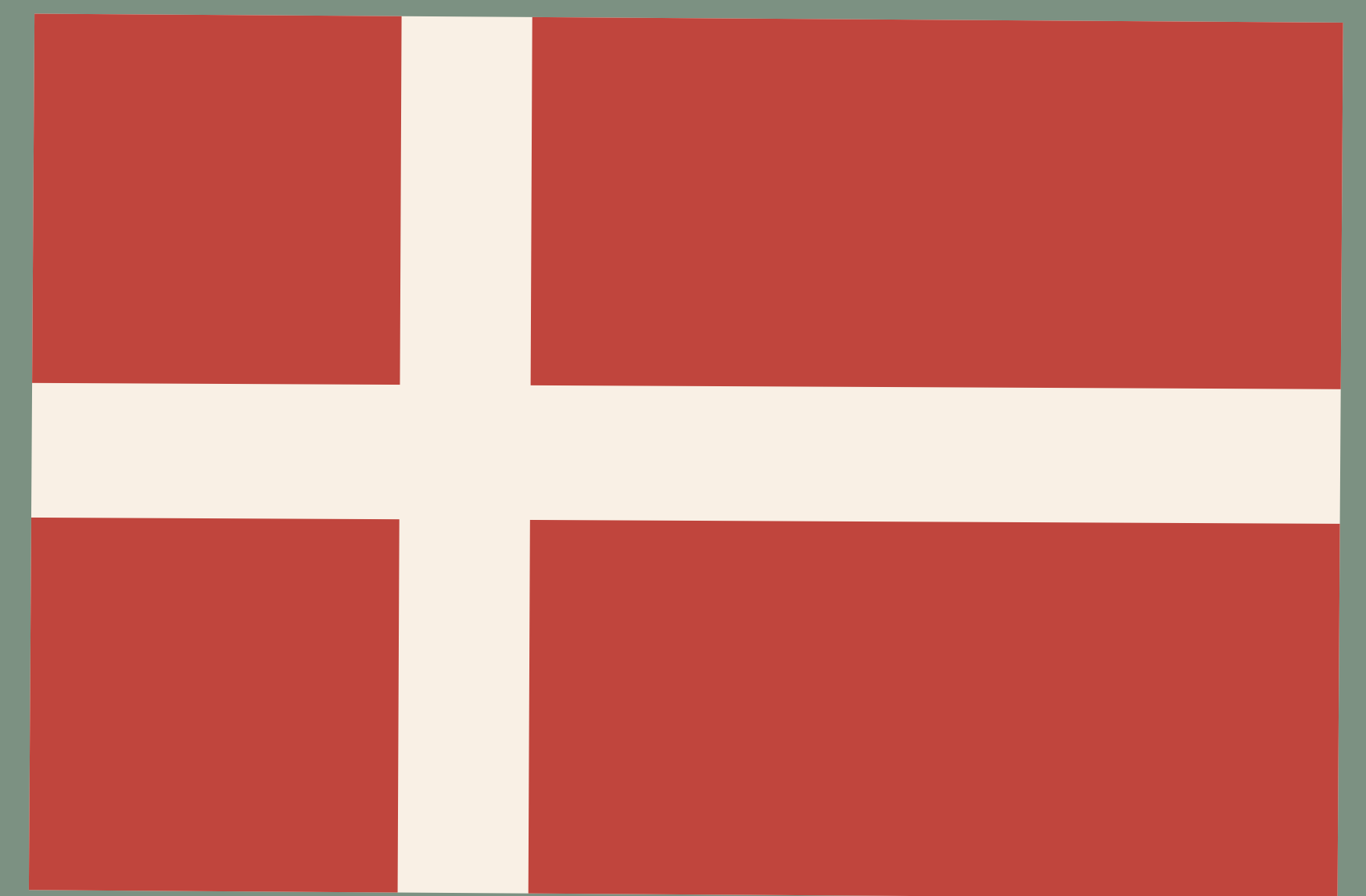

(yeh)

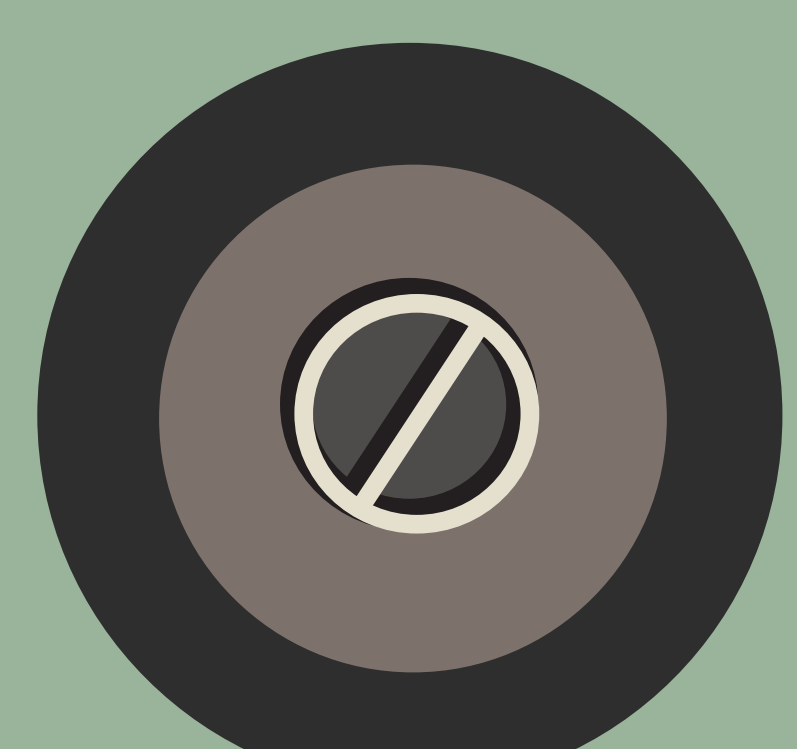
No **nej**
