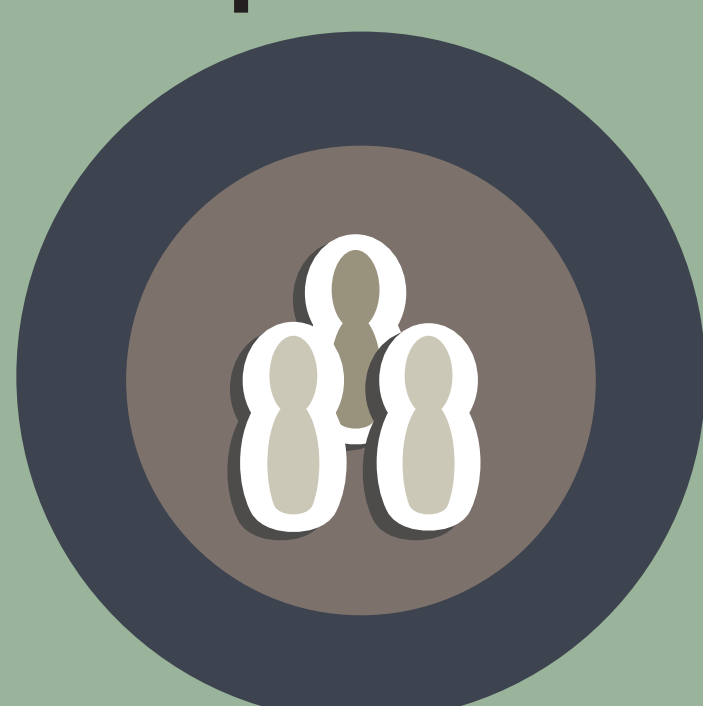

(OO-shenk-ta)

English? **engelska**  
(AYN-ghel-ska)

Yes **ja**  
(yah)

No **nej**  
(nay)

Swede's are reserved. Avoid affectionate touching and emotional displays in public
