CIEE Fall Semester Program	+	CIEE Spring Semester Program
Cal Poly in Rome: Architecture Fall	+	CIEE Spring Semester Program

Other program combinations in addition to those listed above may also pose challenges. It is each student's responsibility to research and apply for all appropriate visas and country entry requirements prior to departure for all study abroad programs.

### Apply by December 15th

- Complete an Architecture Off-Campus Planning Preference Form for your 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> ranked off-campus programs. Follow instructions on the Architecture Student Resources Off-Campus Canvas Page.
- o Follow the Architecture Department instructions for faculty recommendations.
- o Complete the CPIC Application for your 1st choice program only as follows:
- Navigate to specific programs on the study abroad website (abroad.calpoly.edu), and click 'Apply Now.'
- You may only apply for one program per term (e.g., summer, fall, winter, spring, academic year).
- After you submit your applications, the architecture department will either 'nominate' you to those programs
  or ask you to switch to one of your back-up preferences.

### Get accepted to programs

- After you submit your applications, the architecture department will review all applications nominating you to programs you have been selected for.
- Only students nominated by the architecture department will be considered for acceptance to each program.
- Students nominated to CSU IP, CIEE, or International Exchanges must also complete a secondary application on the partner's website.
- Acceptances are announced via email; dates vary by program.
- Accepted students will attend mandatory group orientations in the spring, prior to departure.
