Important notes about program combinations

The following combinations of back-to-back programs are not recommended due to requirements for obtaining visas prior to departure:

Cal Poly in Ticino, Switzerland: Arch Summer	+	CIEE Barcelona Fall -OR- CSU IP Germany Academic Year
CIEE Fall Semester Program	+	CIEE Spring Semester Program
Cal Poly in Rome: Architecture Fall	+	CIEE Barcelona Spring

Other program combinations in addition to those listed above may also pose particular challenges. It is each student's responsibility to research and apply for all appropriate visas and country entry requirements prior to departure for all study abroad programs.

Apply to your top choices by January 17

- Navigate to specific programs on the study abroad website (abroad.calpoly.edu), and click 'Apply Now.'
- You may only apply for one program per term (e.g., summer, fall, winter, spring, academic year).
- Each application requires you to write a brief personal statement about why that particular program is a good fit for you. If you apply to several programs, you will need to write a statement for each one.
- Each application requires two faculty recommendations.
- After you submit your applications, the architecture department will either 'nominate' you to those programs, or ask you to switch to one of your back-up preferences.
- Students applying to CEA, CSU IP, CIEE, or International Exchanges must also complete a secondary application on the partner's website.

Get accepted to programs

- Only students nominated by the architecture department will be considered for acceptance to each program.
- Acceptances are announced via email; dates vary by program.
- Accepted students will attend mandatory group orientations in the spring, prior to departure.
